A Few Fun Facts for **2024**

2024 was a showstopper-from big games to Broadway and beyond.

The Fox Cities CVB Sports Marketing team was on fire in 2024, lighting up the scoreboard with 257 events, 33,340 room nights, and \$13.8 million in direct visitor spending. The team already scored some future wins, securing 269 events, over 37,000 room nights, and an estimated \$15.7 million in visitor spending for events in future years.

But it's not all fun and games in the Fox Cities—we take our meetings and conventions pretty seriously. In 2024, our Group Sales team brought 57 meetings and conventions to the Fox Cities. Those events filled over 12,600 room nights and generated an impressive \$4 million in direct visitor spending. With 50 more events already on the books for future years bringing an estimated 10,645 room nights and \$3.5 million in future visitor spending, the meetings and convention market is gaining plenty of steam.

Part of our mission is to fuel the Fox Cities by awarding tourism development grants to places and spaces that promote tourism and bring people to our community. In 2024, we awarded \$1.6 million in tourism development grants, supporting attractions like the

Building for Kids' Food to Grow exhibit and kayak rental kiosks in five municipalities - making it easier and more affordable for people to enjoy our beautiful waters."

To be memorable, you have to deliver memorable experiences—and we couldn't do it without the hard work and dedication of our amazing staff and volunteers. Together we welcomed thousands of visitors, directly supported 89 groups, and logged 208 volunteer hours.

We worked hard to get our name in lights and tell the story of the Fox Cities as a destination, producing 98 feature stories and generating more than 230,000 unique website visits.




